Subject: Consider purchase of an asphalt roller and trailer from Associated

Supply Company, Inc. in the amount of \$56,340.00 through a BuyBoard

Cooperative Contract.

Summary:

The 2017-18 budget includes the replacement of an asphalt roller and trailer for the Public Works Department. It is being recommended to purchase this equipment from Associated Supply Company, Inc. (ASCO) through BuyBoard Contract #515-16.

General Description:

A 1998 Hamm roller and 1998 C&S trailer utilized by the Public Works Department are scheduled to be replaced. The existing roller is having mechanical issues and needs to be replaced. The Hamm roller is also too light and does not compact and smooth the roadway to the specifications desired.

The City of North Richland Hills is a member of several inter-local groups and utilizes existing contracts with vendors through the Local Government Purchasing Cooperatives.

ASCO has submitted BuyBoard quote contract #515-16 in the amount of \$56,340 for a Case DV36 9,000 pound roller. The quote also included a trade-in value of \$10,961.05 for the Hamm roller. The trade in value being offered is a good value for the age of this equipment. The city has conducted previous business with ASCO with good results.

Recommendation:

Approve purchase of an asphalt roller and trailer from Associated Supply Company, Inc. in the amount of \$56,340.00 through a BuyBoard Cooperative Contract.
