SUBJECT: Authorize the purchase of two Chevrolet Tahoes from Lake Country Chevrolet through The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) USA Contract No. 210907 in the amount of \$165,972.62 using the Texas Anti-Gang Center Grant #2848909 funding, and consider Resolution No. 2024-012, authorizing the City Manager to execute a Regional Asset Transfer Addendum with the City of Dallas.

SUMMARY:

The City of North Richland Hills ("NRH") serves as the fiduciary and grant recipient for the FY2024 North Texas Anti-Gang Center ("TAG") Project Grant #2848909. The grant award includes funding for the purchase of two Chevrolet Tahoes from Lake Country Chevrolet through TIPS USA Contract No. 210907 in the amount of \$165,972.62 and the subsequent transfer of ownership and responsibility of the assets to the City of Dallas ("Dallas").

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Staff is requesting authorization to purchase two Chevrolet Tahoes with full K9 buildout from Lake Country Chevrolet through TIPS USA Contract No. 210907 in the amount of \$165,972.62 using allocated funds awarded under the FY2024 TAG Grant #2848909. The City of North Richland Hills is a member of several inter-local groups and utilizes existing contracts with vendors through the Local Government Purchasing Cooperatives. Using TIPS USA Contract No. 210907 satisfies any state law competitive bidding requirements.

Approval of purchasing and transferring the two Tahoes was previously approved with Resolution 2023-035 using TAG Grant 2848908 funds; however, the vehicles were not received within the grant period. The vehicles will now be purchased and transferred with TAG Grant #2848909 funds.

Upon execution of a Regional Asset Transfer Addendum, NRH will transfer ownership and responsibility of these assets to the City of Dallas. As the receiving jurisdiction, Dallas agrees to maintain compliance with the laws, rules and regulations of the grant, including compliance with all state and federal grant eligibility requirements as outlined in the addendum.
