How to Participate in the **MAYOR'S SUMMER READING CLUB**

The Mayor's Summer Reading Club (MSRC) is a free, self-paced reading program designed for all ages to prevent learning loss over the summer. There are plenty of prizes, activities, and performances to keep you engaged along the way!

SIGN UP

Use the QR code or download the Beanstack app, and search for the NRH Library! You can sign up starting May 18.

READ

Read anything you like: books, manga, comics, audiobooks; they all count!

TRACK & LOG

Use Beanstack to record how many minutes you spend reading and any activities you complete.



EARN BADGES

As you progress through the Mayor's Summer Reading Club, you'll earn virtual badges. Some badges will earn you rewards and virtual tickets!



REWARDS & GRAND PRIZES

In the MSRC program, there are two types of prizes you can earn. **Rewards** are given based on the number of hours you read. As you complete certain activities in Beanstack, you'll earn virtual tickets to use for a chance to win **grand prizes!** Rewards include coupons from local businesses, NRH Centre day passes, and other fun surprises!



NRH₂O Day Passes

Kids aged 3-17 can earn a day pass for NRH₂O by reading 50 hours during MSRC. Children need to be present and have a valid NRH Library card to get the pass.



Fire Truck Rides

If you read 100 hours, you can enter a drawing to ride to school in an NRH Fire Truck! To qualify, you must be in elementary school, live in North Richland Hills, and go to school in NRH or be homeschooled.



Grand Prizes

To use your tickets, go to the "Drawings" tab in Beanstack, pick your favorite prizes, and choose how many tickets to enter for each. Children, teens, and adults each have their own set of prizes. From gift cards and toys to cool tech, there's something for everyone! Winners are randomly chosen after the program ends.

Rewards are available while supplies last or until 4:00 PM on Sat., August 1

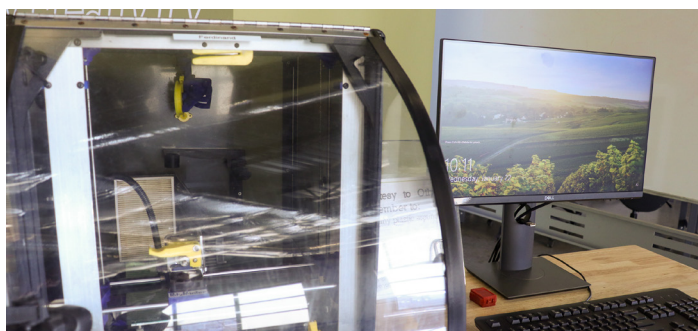

Unlock Creativity in The Maker Spot

Did you know there is a 4,500 ft² self-service makerspace on the second floor of the North Richland Hills Library? Use of The Maker Spot is free for all North Richland Hills residents with an NRH Library card. We currently have 15 reservable equipment stations ranging from sewing and embroidery machines to 3D printers and even a scroll saw!
