CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM ADVISORY COMMITTEE REQUESTS UPDATE

Ms. Barham reported to the board the Library Expansion and Renovation Project Proposal she presented to the Capital Improvement Advisory Committee. The demonstration included last fiscal year numbers of visitors, checkouts, program attendance, materials collections, programs, Library facilities' history s and current situation.

The project goals are to expand the community room; to create a family friendly first floor; to expand the Children's area; to have additional study and collaboration rooms, and to expand the Circulation workroom. Ms. Barham opened room for discussion and answered questions.
