SUBJECT: Authorize the execution of Amendment No. 1 to the Cooperative

Purchase Customer Agreement with Wireless Watchdogs, LLC for the purchase of managed mobility services and ratify previous purchases totaling \$46,273 utilizing The Interlocal Purchasing System (TIPS) Cooperative Agreement for a cumulative amount not

to exceed \$81,250 through fiscal year 2026.

SUMMARY:

Staff requests City Council to consider approving the purchase of managed mobility services (MMS) provided by Wireless Watchdogs, LLC, through TIPS Cooperative Contract No. 210602 in a cumulative amount not to exceed \$81,250 through fiscal year 2026.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Wireless Watchdogs, LLC is an authorized reseller for Todo Verde Consulting Ventures, LLC and provides MMS for the City's cellular and data plans. The City will be purchasing this service from Wireless Watchdogs using TIPS 210602 with Todo Verde Consulting Ventures, LLC. This contract expires August 31, 2026.

In accordance with the current Cooperative Purchase Customer Agreement, the City has spent \$46,273 with Wireless Watchdogs to date. Staff would like to continue using the MMS as these services have realized a reduction in cellular and data expenses. With MMS, Wireless Watchdogs manages the account to ensure continual cost efficiency with our mobile carrier plans. This service also manages the entire lifecycle of the City's mobile device fleet, saving staff time.

As a reseller, Wireless Watchdogs participates in The Interlocal Purchasing System cooperative purchasing program. By participating in this program, the city satisfies any state law requirement for competitive bidding.
