SUBJECT: Consider Resolution No. 2020-039, authorizing the submission of a reimbursement application and acceptance of allocated funds if awarded for Tarrant County 9-1-1 District FY2021 Public Safety Answering Points Assistance Program in the amount of \$57,296.

SUMMARY:

The Tarrant County 9-1-1 District (TC9-1-1) FY2021 Public Safety Answering Points (PSAP) Assistance Program provides reimbursement for pre-determined allowable expenses that are reviewed annually by the TC9-1-1 Board of Managers. Under the FY2021 PSAP Assistance Program, the Police Department will request reimbursement of up to \$57,296 for the Computer Aided Dispatch/Records Management System (CAD/RMS) annual service agreement.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

TC9-1-1 determines the amount of the total available funding under the PSAP Program, the annual funding request limits and disbursements, as well as the parameters for utilization of the funding. The Police Department is eligible to request funding through the PSAP Program reimbursement process. TC9-1-1 has notified the city that our agency's FY2021 PSAP Program allocation is \$57,296.

Allowable expenses are limited to PSAP-related equipment, maintenance, furniture, training, etc. supporting the communications/dispatch setting. Under the FY2021 PSAP, the Police Department will submit to TC9-1-1 an application for funding up to \$57,296 for reimbursement of the annual service agreement apportioned total with Motorola Solutions for the CAD/RMS annual service agreement. Once the invoice payment has been made by the City to Motorola for the CAD/RMS annual service agreement, the Police Department will submit a reimbursement request to TC9-1-1. The deadline to submit the reimbursement request is August 31, 2021.
