**Summary:**

This is for the replacement of a 2017 Ford Interceptor for the Police Department. It is being recommended to purchase this vehicle from Sam Pack's Five Star Ford through Tarrant County Contract #2016-006.

**General Description:**

This is for the replacement of a 2017 Ford Interceptor for the Police Department. Unit 8023 was involved in an accident that totaled the vehicle. This vehicle is being funded by the money received as an insurance reimbursement. The table below identifies the new replacement vehicle for City Council's consideration.
