

QUICK REFERENCE CITY OF NORTH RICHLAND HILLS POLITICAL SIGN REGULATIONS CITY HALL, 4301 CITY POINT DRIVE

Signs during Early Voting and Election Day Voting

- Unlighted political signs not exceeding three feet in height <u>and</u> with no more than six square feet of sign face on any side may be posted on the grounds of any building owned by the City used for voting during an early voting period or during an election day voting period, as long as such sign is outside the distance where electioneering is prohibited by the State.
- **Early Voting Period** Early voting period is defined as beginning with the commencement of early voting by personal appearance and ending after the polls close on the last day for early voting by personal appearance for an early voting polling place.
- **Election Day Voting Period** Beginning when the polls open on Election Day and ending when the polls close on Election Day for an election day polling place. (See Sec. 43.031(f), Texas Election Code).
- Such signs shall not overhang any sidewalk or driveway.
- Such signs shall be anchored with H-wire stakes, not t-posts or wooden stakes.
- Such signs may not be affixed to a building in any manner.
- Tents/sitting area shall not be located within parking spaces or the drive aisles.
- Signs located in the green space shall be removed by 5:00 p.m. on the days that the City has a
 scheduled event at the facility and may be replaced after the conclusion of the scheduled
 event. Signs that are not removed by 5:00 p.m. for a special event shall be removed by the City
 and stored for pick-up during regular business hours.
