SUBJECT: Consider Ordinance No. 3414, amending the City's Code of

Ordinances Chapter 98, Article XII - Aquatics Facilities

SUMMARY:

Consider Ordinance No. 3414, amending the City's Code of Ordinances Chapter 98, Article XII – Aquatics Facilities. Also consider retitling the Code from Swimming Pools to Aquatics Facilities.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The purpose of this article is the establishment and amendment of the minimum standards for the construction, operation and maintenance of public and semipublic aquatic facilities. Due to the additional types of facilities now available it is recommended that the title of the Code be changed from Swimming Pools to Aquatics Facilities. Further, this code reflects and formalizes current inspection methods by Consumer Health and requirements set forth by State law.

This amendment also allows for reinspection fees due to closure or pre-operation failures of public or semipublic aquatics facilities. Additionally there is a nominal fee now allowed for the registration of Certified Pool Operators for these facilities.

RECOMMENDATION:

To approve Ordinance No. 3414.
