SUBJECT: Consider Resolution No. 2023-065, designating the Chief of Police as the grantee's authorized official for the Office of the Governor's FY23 Bullet-Resistant Shield Program, Grant #4631601.

SUMMARY:

The city is currently the grantee for the Office of the Governor's FY23 Bullet-Resistant Shield Program, Grant #4631601. The Police Department is purchasing 15 full-size ballistic shields to be issued to school resource officers (SRO) assigned to Birdville Independent School District. To accept and commit funds on behalf of the Police Department, an authorized official must be designated and granted authority by the grantee's governing body.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

An authorized official must be designated and granted authority by the grantee's governing body for the FY23 Bullet-Resistant Shield Program, Grant #4631601, offered through the Office of the Governor.

Staff is requesting that Chief of Police Mike Young be designated as the authorized official and be given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the funding request on behalf of the North Richland Hills Police Department.
