



## CITY COUNCIL MEMORANDUM

**SUBJECT:** Authorize the City Manager to execute an interlocal agreement with Tarrant County to rehabilitate and resurface Meadow Road from Chapman Road to Hightower Drive.

### **SUMMARY:**

The City Council is being asked to allow the City Manager to execute an interlocal agreement between Tarrant County and the City of North Richland Hills for road construction work on Meadow Road.

### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

Over the past few years Tarrant County Field Operations, specifically Precinct No. 3 has helped the city complete various street construction projects. Most recently county forces rehabilitated Susan Lee Lane in 2018. This partnership allows the city to stretch maintenance dollars by taking advantage of the county's in-house capabilities.

The proposed 2020 project is Meadow Road from Chapman Road to Hightower Drive, and will include full sub-grade stabilization followed by a new asphalt surface.

The terms and conditions of the agreement replicate those used in prior years. The city will pay for the materials, trucking charges and one half of the fuel used by Tarrant County for the sub-grade stabilization process and the placement of the asphalt in the roadway. Once the agreement is executed staff will coordinate with the county to schedule the work. At this time, it appears that the work will take place in late March of 2020. The work is estimated to take 3 to 4 weeks to complete.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Authorize the City Manager to execute an interlocal agreement with Tarrant County to rehabilitate and resurface Meadow Road from Chapman Road to Hightower Drive.
