

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-037

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RICHLAND HILLS, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AND ENDORSING THE APPLICATION FOR THE 2023 OUR TOWN PROGRAM BY THE NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FOR THE ARTS FOR VARIOUS CREATIVE PLACEMAKING PROJECTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE WISHING SPOT PROJECT AT LINDA SPURLOCK PARK, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of North Richland Hills is committed to integrating art into daily life and beautifying public areas, whereby improving our quality of life and creating a distinctive identity for our community; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Richland Hills is also dedicated to bringing the arts in an affordable and accessible way to the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Richland Hills recognizes that encouraging creative placemaking projects with arts at their core has a positive effect on the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the National Endowment for the Arts offers a "Our Town" Program in which a certain amount of federal funding is earmarked for creative placemaking projects that contribute toward the livability of communities and help transform them into lively, beautiful, and sustainable places with the arts at their core; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Richland Hills is planning to submit an "Our Town" grant application to infuse art and artful projects; and

WHEREAS, the art projects will be located at Linda Spurlock Park; and

WHEREAS, Social Transportation for Seniors, a non-profit community engagement provider, will partner with the City in its "Our Town" grant request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RICHLAND HILLS, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby finds that the recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution as if written herein.

SECTION 2. The application for funding from the National Endowment for the Arts Our Town Program is hereby authorized and endorsed for the project area.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption, and it is so resolved; and all Resolutions of the City Council of the City in conflict herewith are hereby amended or repealed to the extent of such conflict.
