## **SUMMARY:**

Consider a resolution endorsing the application of City Council member Tito Rodriguez to serve on the 2018 National League of Cities Board of Directors.

## **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

The National League of Cities (NLC) is dedicated to helping city leaders build better communities. NLC is a resource and advocate for 19,000 cities, town and villages, representing more than 218 million Americans. NLC is governed by a board of directors that is comprised of four officers and 43 at-large members.

Council member Rodriguez was originally appointed to the board in 2016 to serve a one-year term. Council member Rodriguez is interested in continuing to represent Texas on the board of directors. The application process requires that each candidate must have the endorsement of his/her city council.

The purpose of this item is to formally adopt a resolution, endorsing the application of Council member Tito Rodriguez to serve on the 2018 NLC Board of Directors.
