SUBJECT: Authorize the purchase of four police-equipped motorcycles, in the combined total amount of \$184,245.60, from Longhorn Harley-Davidson, utilizing BuyBoard Contract #724-23 and approve Amendment No. 2 to the Customer Cooperative Purchase Agreement with Longhorn Harley-Davidson authorizing the total expenditure of \$290,000 through November 30, 2026.

SUMMARY:

City Council is being asked to authorize the purchase of three Harley-Davidson Police-Equipped Motorcycles in the amount of \$143,605.45 and one Harley-Davidson Police-Equipped Motorcycle (Demo Model) in the amount of \$40,640.15 for a combined total amount of \$184,245.60, from Longhorn Harley-Davidson, utilizing BuyBoard Contract #724-23, expiring November 30, 2026. In order to facilitate this purchase, the City will execute Amendment No. 2 to the Customer Cooperative Purchase Agreement with Longhorn Harley-Davidson increasing the total expenditure amount under the contract to \$290,000 through November 30, 2026.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The following table identifies the Police-Equipped Harley-Davidson motorcycles proposed for purchase under BuyBoard Contract #724-23. These units will be maintained by Public Works / Fleet Department and support Police Department operations and replace aging fleet assets, ensuring officers have reliable and properly equipped vehicles for patrol and enforcement activities.

Longhorn Harley-Davidson provided current pricing utilizing BuyBoard Contract #724-23. With this purchase cumulative spending under this contract will be amended, creating a new not to exceed amount of \$290,000 through its expiration on November 30, 2026. This purchase requires no new debt, as all associated expenses are fully supported by previously approved FY26 Fleet Operating Budget allocations.

The City remains committed to responsible purchasing practices and utilizes cooperative procurement contracts such as BuyBoard to satisfy state competitive bidding requirements. The City also maintains a long-standing and productive relationship with Longhorn Harley-Davidson, ensuring dependable service, transparent pricing, and timely delivery of specialized Police fleet equipment.
