SUBJECT: Authorize the City Manager to execute an interlocal agreement

with the City of Graham for the purchase of slurry seal and other goods and services from vendors selected through the competitive

bidding process.

SUMMARY:

The City of Graham is requesting to enter into an interlocal agreement for the purchase of slurry seal and other goods and services from vendors selected through the competitive bidding process.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The City of Graham ("Graham") is requesting to enter into an interlocal agreement for the purchase of goods and services from vendors selected through the competitive bidding process. Graham is interested in purchasing from a current City of North Richland Hills contract for Slurry Sealing (RFB 20-019, Intermountain Slurry Seal). Council has authorized several of these interlocal agreements in the past and they have been mutually beneficial to North Richland Hills and the other agencies. Participation reduces the overall expense of soliciting bids and purchasing in larger quantities often lowers the cost of the goods and/or services. Each agency will place their orders and pay the vendors directly. The City of North Richland Hills or Graham may change or cancel the agreement with a 30-day written notice. North Richland Hills currently participates in interlocal agreements with several local governments throughout the DFW Metroplex and various parts of Texas.

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Manager to execute an interlocal agreement with the City of Graham for the purchase of slurry seal and other goods and services from vendors selected through the competitive bidding process.
