

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-017

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RICHLAND HILLS, TEXAS, APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE LIBRARY BOARD, PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION, AND TEEN COURT ADVISORY BOARD; ESTABLISHING TERM; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City Council appoints members of the public to serve on various boards, commissions, and committees to serve a two-year term, unless appointed to fulfill an unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, annual appointments coincide with City Council terms with Places 1, 3, 5, and 7 being appointed in odd-numbered years and Places 2, 4, 6, and Mayoral appointments in even-numbered years; and

WHEREAS, each member serves until their successor has been duly appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, the City Secretary is in receipt of Lisa Maritnez's resignation from the Library Board, Bryan Kidd's resignation from the Planning and Zoning Commission, and Vicki Seay's resignation from the Teen Court Advisory Board; and

WHEREAS, Mayor McCarty, Associate Mayor Pro Tem Rodriguez and Council member Blake forwarded their recommendations to fulfill the unexpired terms expiring June 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RICHLAND HILLS, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Resolution.
