SUBJECT: Update on Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) grant projects for trails, roadway and sidewalk improvements.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Mr. Joe Pack, Senior Park Planner, will give a status update on the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Project known as North Richland Hills Active Transportation Projects for Trails and On-Road Systems. Projects include bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements for the following locations:

1. Solar powered rapid flashing beacons at trails and roadway intersections
 - A. The JoAnn Johnson Trail and Rufe Snow Drive
 - B. The John Barfield Trail and Rumfield Road
 - C. The John Barfield Trail and Kirk Lane
2. High visibility intersection and sidewalk improvements
 - A. Mid Cities Blvd and Iron Horse Drive
3. Cotton Belt Trail crossing improvements
 - A. Precinct Line Road and Glade Road
4. High visibility intersection and curb ramp improvements
 - A. Londonderry/ Valley Drives at Bursey Road
5. Bicycle Boulevards
 - A. Buckingham Trail between Mid Cities Blvd and Richfield Park
 - B. Chapman Drive from Richfield Park to south end of Graham Ranch
 - C. Hightower Drive from north end of Graham Ranch to Douglas Lane
 - D. Starnes Road from Douglas Lane to Adventure World Park south end of Cross Timbers Park.
 - E. Waterford/Londonderry Drive from north end of Cross Timbers Park to Bursey Road.
 - F. Valley Drive from Bursey Road to Continental Trail.
6. 911 Emergency location signage every ¼ mile on all City off-road trails
 - A. JoAnn Johnson Trail
 - B. Randy Moresi Trail
