Defibrillators from Stryker Sales, LLC through a Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing agreement contract number 041823 in the

amount of \$478,908.95 utilizing ARPA funds.

## **SUMMARY:**

Authorize the purchase of seven Lifepak 35 Cardiac Monitor Defibrillators from Stryker Sales, LLC through a Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing agreement contract number 041823 in the amount of \$478,908.95 utilizing ARPA funds.

## **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

The North Richland Hills Fire Department is replacing the remaining seven of the ten total Lifepak 15 model Cardiac Monitor Defibrillators with new Lifepak 35 model Cardiac Monitor Defibrillators. The Lifepak 15 units currently in service are all reaching or have exceeded their operational life and are no longer serviceable. The replacement of these units was delayed for several years due to a delay in the release of the new Lifepak 35 units. This purchase of seven units will address the replacement of the remaining units currently in use. Three of the ten total units were replaced last fiscal year. This purchase is funded through capital project IT2510 and is within budget. IT2510 utilizes ARPA funding. Approval of this purchase will allow staff to meet all financial deadlines associated with ARPA expenditures.

The Local Government Code states that purchases made through a cooperative purchasing agreement satisfy any state law that would require the city to solicit competitive bids. Stryker Sales, LLC is an approved vendor through the Sourcewell Contract 041823.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**
