



## CITY COUNCIL MEMORANDUM

**SUBJECT:** Consider authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement for roadway lime slurry materials with Martin Marietta Materials, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 per year, utilizing Tarrant County contract F2024-066.

### **SUMMARY:**

The City Council is being asked to consider an agreement with Martin Marietta Materials for lime slurry materials utilizing Tarrant County contract F2024-066 pursuant to an interlocal agreement between Tarrant County and the City of North Richland Hills.

### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

Lime slurry is mixed into the native soil just below the pavement surface to prepare the sub-grade that will support the pavement structure. It is a critical step in any construction project involving paved surfaces, as the strength and stability of the subgrade directly impact the longevity and performance of the overlying pavement layers. Once the agreement is executed, staff will coordinate with Tarrant County to schedule the delivery of materials through Martin Marietta. This project is part of the partnership with Tarrant County Precinct 3 in the rehabilitation of Bursey Road that was approved earlier this year. Utilizing an interlocal agreement satisfies any state law that would require the city to solicit competitive bids.

Funding for this agreement is available within capital project SM2501 which was included in the adopted FY 2026 Capital Budget.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**
