## **SUMMARY:**

Consider recommending ballot provisions to City Council for proposed Charter amendments.

## **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

At the Charter Review Commission meeting on May 27, 2025, the Commission voted to approve certain ballot provisions for recommendation to City Council. Several of those motions required amendment to the proposed ballot language, so this item is intended to present the final ballot language to the Commission for approval and recommendation to the City Council for proposed Charter amendments.

The final proposed ballot language is included with this memo, as well as the final proposed Charter language that this ballot language is intended to adopt.

After this recommendation is made to the City Council, the City Council will have authority, pursuant to Section 9.004, Texas Local Government Code, on its own motion to submit proposed Charter amendments to the City's qualified voters for their approval at an election, which may be ordered by ordinance.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Recommend the presented ballot provisions to the City Council for proposed Charter amendments.
