SUBJECT: Consider Resolution No. 2024-037, authorizing the City Manager to execute a Regional Asset Transfer Addendum with the City of North Richland Hills to transfer equipment purchased by the City of North Richland Hills using TAG Grant #2848909 funds.

SUMMARY:

The City of North Richland Hills ("NRH") serves as the fiduciary and grant recipient for the FY2024 North Texas Anti-Gang Center ("TAG") Project Grant. The grant award includes funding for the purchase of pre-approved equipment using TAG Grant #2848909 funds and the subsequent transfer of ownership and responsibility of the assets to the City of North Richland Hills ("North Richland Hills"), a TAG Constituent Agency.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

NRH will be purchasing the following equipment using TAG Grant #2848909 funds:

Mobile Forensic Laptop - \$4,995
Flock Safety Falcon Flex with 24-month subscription- \$8,500
DFI Lab Switch - \$17,869.90
(4) Samsung Galaxy Tab S9 (WiFi Only 64GB), (4) Samsung Smart Keyboards and (4) Samsung Outdoor Covers - \$2,254
(2) Interceptor ebikes - \$11,000

This equipment will be purchased by NRH from multiple vendors in accordance with the City's approved purchasing policies. None of the purchases are collectively over \$50,000 with a single vendor. Upon execution of a Regional Asset Transfer Addendum, the ownership and responsibility of the listed assets will be transferred to North Richland Hills. As the receiving jurisdiction, North Richland Hills agrees to maintain compliance with the laws, rules and regulations of the grant, including compliance with all state and federal grant eligibility requirements as outlined in the addendum.
