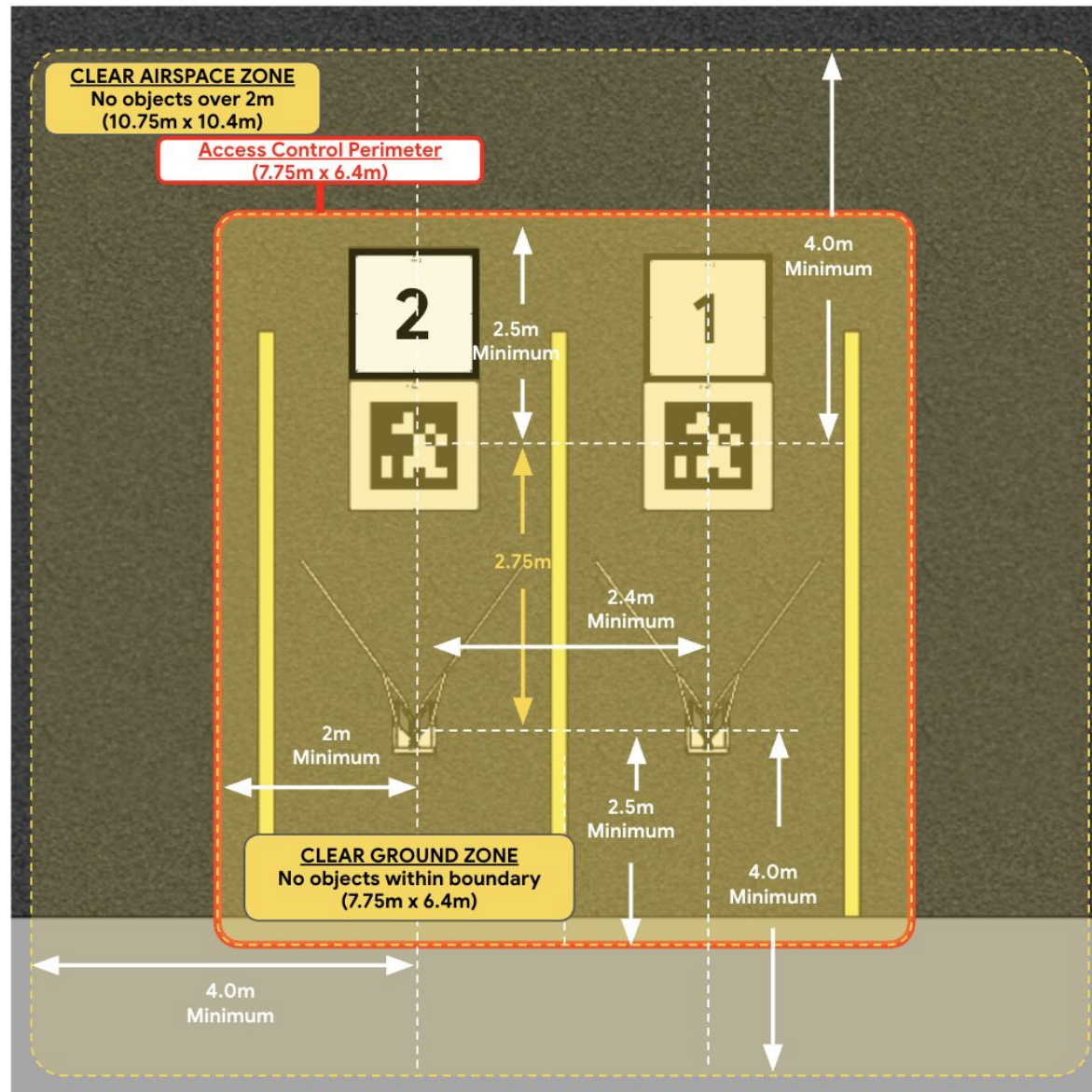

Set-Up Requirements



Clear Airspace Zone



- **No objects over 2m with 4m (13ft.)** of center of fiducial and Autoloader.
- 35.27ft (10.75m) x 34.12ft (10.4m)

Solid Ground

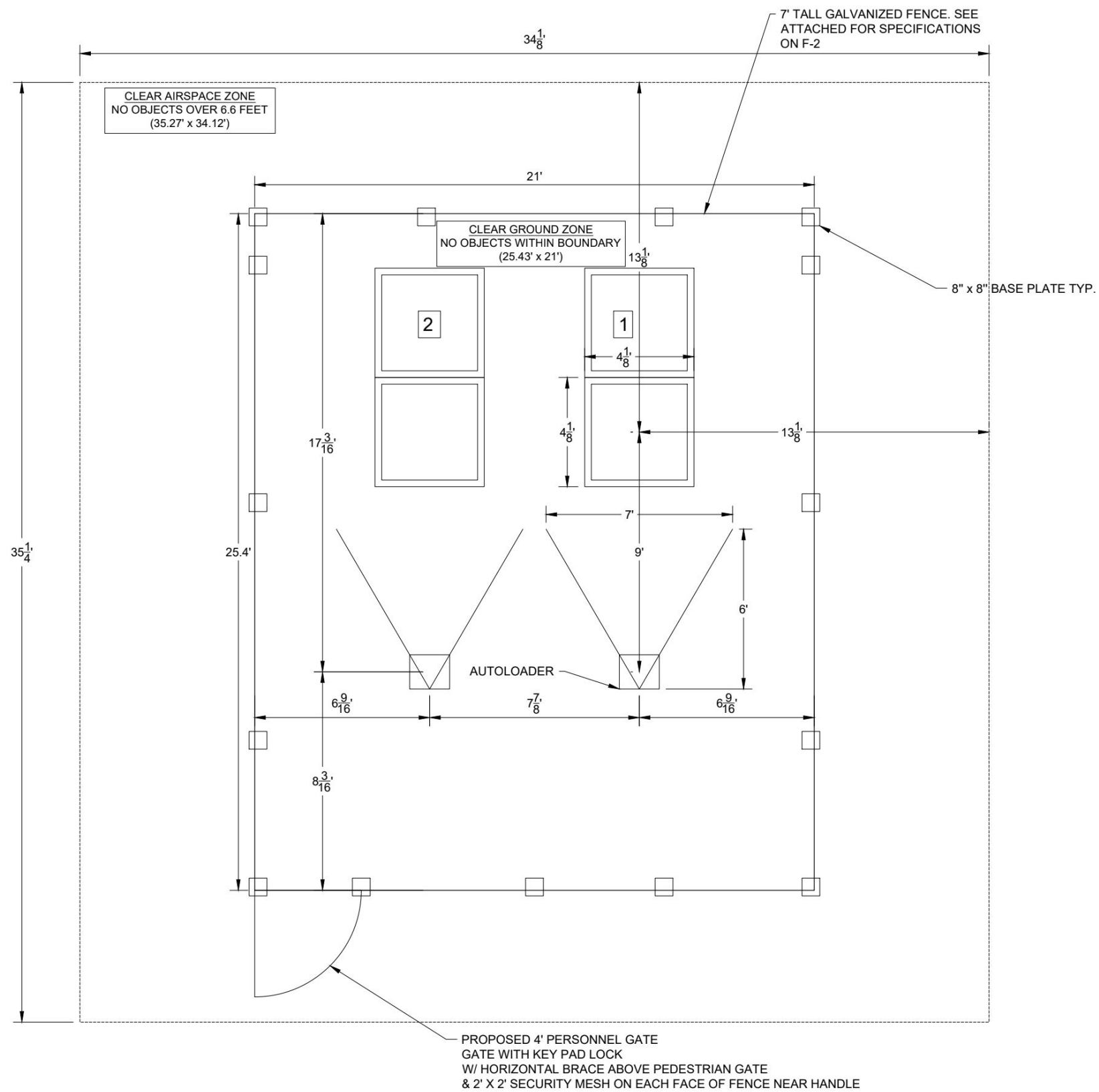


- Should be set on **asphalt or concrete**.
- For soft ground, pouring of a concrete slab would be required.

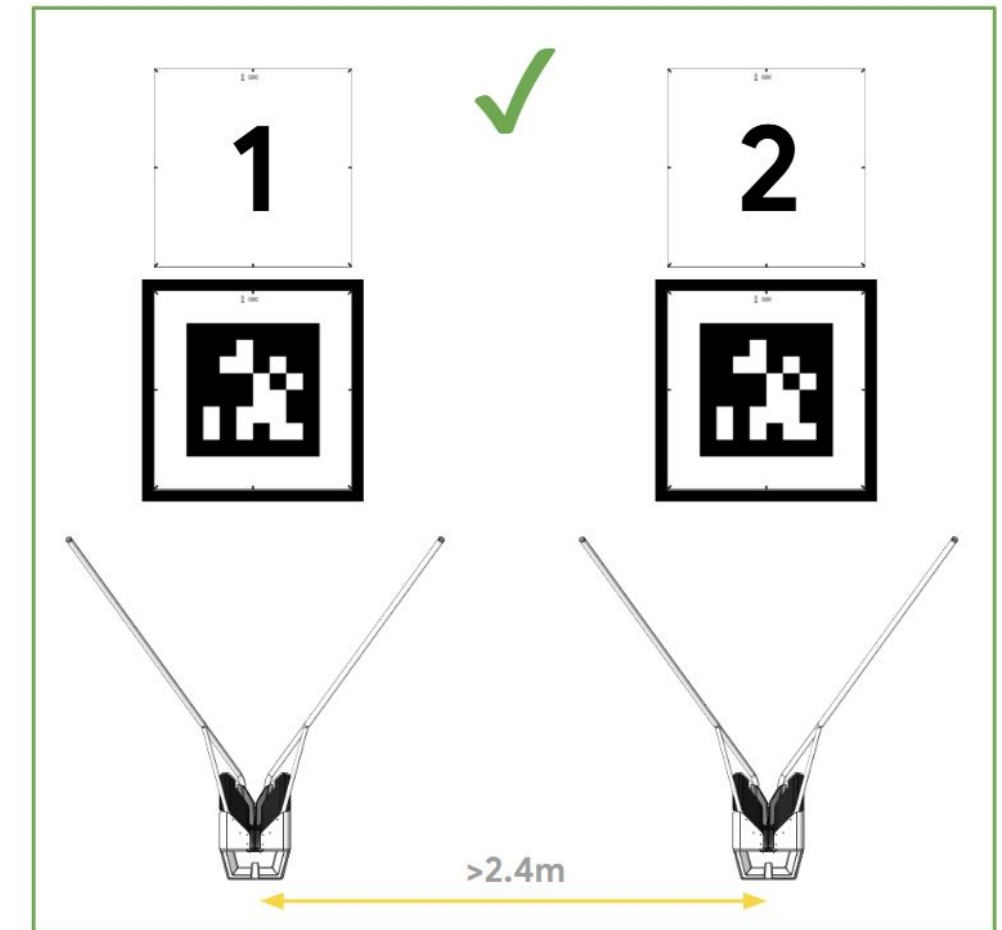
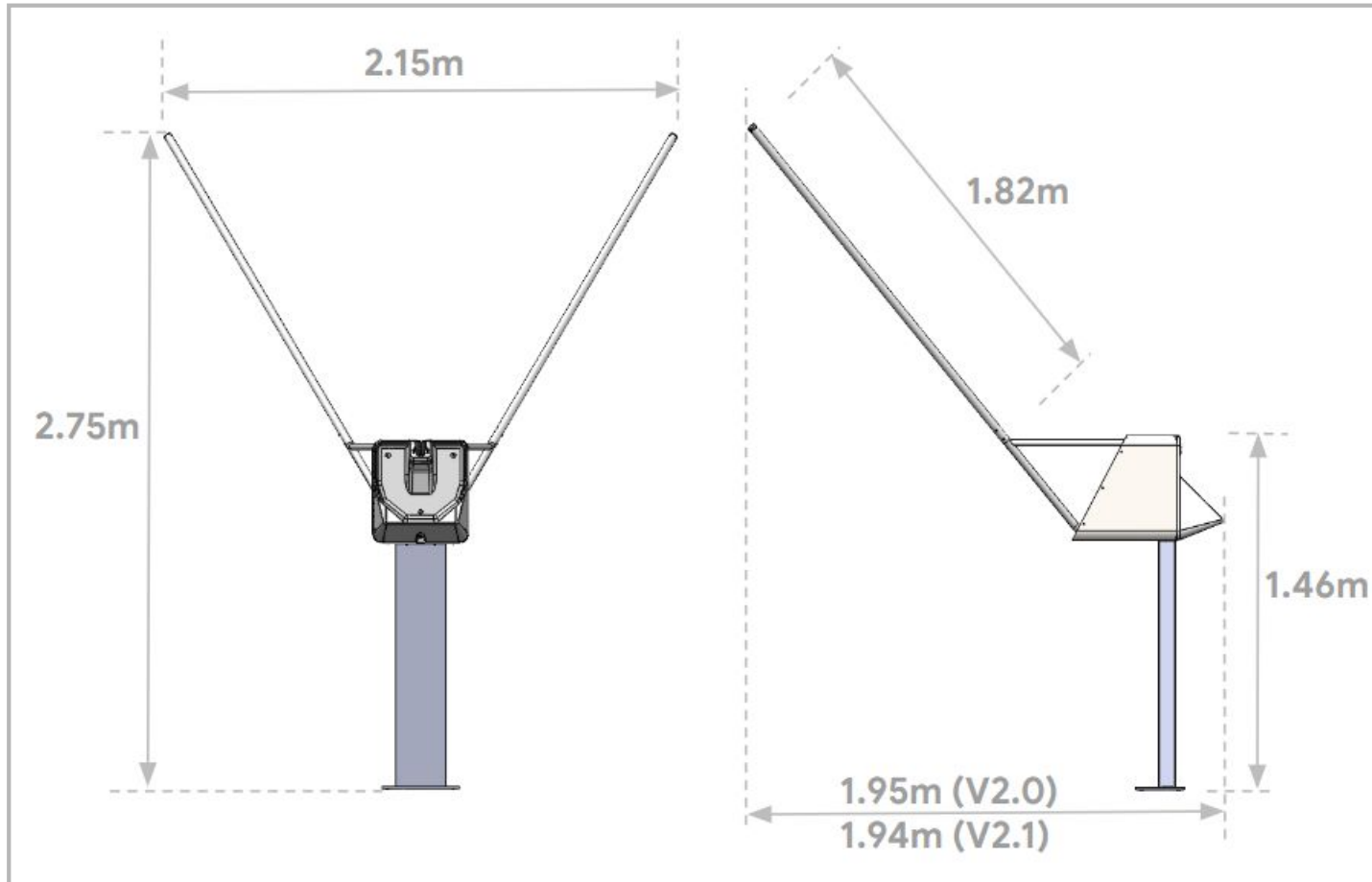
Level Ground



- Autoloaders shall be installed on level that has no more than a **5% grade or slope of 3 degrees.**



Visuals



Must be installed with at least 25m clearance from any overhanging structures or vegetation that have a height-to-bottom-of-overhang of 15m or greater.

Autoloader must be >75ft from noise sensitive receivers (e.g. hospital)
