SUBJECT: Consider Resolution No. 2023-064, designating the Chief of Police as the grantee's authorized official for the Office of the Governor's FY2022 Justice Assistance Grant Program Crime Detection and Prevention Tower, Grant #4448501.

SUMMARY:

The city is currently the grantee for the Office of the Governor's FY2022 Justice Assistance Grant Program Crime Detection and Prevention Tower, grant #4448501. The Police Department is using funds to promote public safety, reduce crime and improve the criminal justice system. To accept and commit funds on behalf of the Police Department, an authorized official must be designated and granted authority by the grantee's governing body.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

An authorized official must be designated and granted authority by the grantee's governing body for the FY2022 Justice Assistance Grant Program Crime Detection and Prevention Tower, grant #4448501 offered through the Office of the Governor.

Staff is requesting that Chief of Police Mike Young be designated as the authorized official and be given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the funding request on behalf of the North Richland Hills Police Department.
