SUBJECT: Accept public official's resignation from City Council Place 5.

SUMMARY:

Accept public official Patrick Faram's resignation from City Council Place 5.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The city is in receipt of Mr. Faram's written resignation from public office, dated June 6, 2022. Pursuant to Texas Election Code, Title 12, Chapter 201, the City Council is the authority to act on a public official's resignation.

Section 201.023 of the Texas Election Code provides that a vacancy occurs the date the resignation is accepted by the appropriate authority, "City Council", or on the eighth day after the date of its receipt by the authority, whichever is earlier.

The resignation creates a vacancy on City Council that will be filled by a special election on November 8, 2022. Staff will place an item on a future meeting to order a special election to fulfill the vacancy for the office with a term expiring May 6, 2023, or until a successor has been duly elected and qualified for the office.

RECOMMENDATION:
