SUBJECT: Consider Resolution No. 2026-043, authorizing the renewal subscriptions for license plate reader devices in the amount of \$60,043.36 using FY 2026 North Texas Anti-Gang Center Grant #2848911 funds and \$278,000 using FY 2027 North Texas Anti-Gang Center Grant #2848912 funds, if awarded, for a total amount of \$338,043.36 and authorizing the City Manager to execute Regional Asset Transfer Addendums with the City of Plano to transfer the subscriptions approved therein.

SUMMARY:

The City of North Richland Hills ("NRH") serves as the fiduciary and grant recipient for the FY 2026 North Texas Anti-Gang Center ("TAG") Project Grant #2848911 and has submitted the FY 2027 TAG Grant #2848912 application. TAG Grant award #2848911 includes funding for a subscription renewal for the City of Plano ("Plano"), a TAG Constituent Agency, for ninety one license plate reader devices in the amount of \$60,043.36 for the period of 06/14/2026 – 08/31/2026. The application for TAG Grant #2848912 includes funding for a subscription renewal for Plano for ninety one license plate reader devices in the amount of \$278,000 for the period of 09/01/2026 – 08/31/2027. The total amount of the contract for Plano for the period of 06/14/2026 - 08/31/2027 is \$338,043.36. The subscription renewal for the purchase with TAG Grant #2848911 funds will be transferred to Plano with Regional Asset Transfer Addendum B_25. The subscription renewal for the purchase with TAG Grant #2848912 will be transferred to Plano if grant funds are awarded.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Falcon™ is an Automatic License Plate Reader ("ALPR") camera system that scans, captures and compares license plate information to vehicles associated with crimes or criminals. The camera network extends an agency's capacity to identify accurate and objective leads and assess crime spots.

Staff is requesting authorization to renew the service subscription for ninety one license plate reader devices in the amount of \$60,043.36 for the period of 06/14/2026 – 08/31/2026 with TAG Grant #2848911 funds and \$278,000 for the period of 09/01/2026 - 08/31/2027 with TAG Grant #2848912 funds, if awarded, for a total amount of \$338,043.36. Flock Safety is the manufacturer and developer of the Falcon camera and is the sole provider of the



monitoring and processing services which integrate with Plano's existing ALPR Camera system. Staff has provided sufficient sole source documentation for this purchase.

Upon execution of Regional Asset Transfer Addendum B_25, NRH will transfer ownership and responsibility of the subscription for the period of 06/14/2026 – 08/31/2026 to Plano. The subscription renewal for the purchase with TAG Grant #2848912 for the period of 09/01/2026 – 08/31/2027 will be transferred to Plano if grant funds are awarded. As the receiving jurisdiction, Plano agrees to maintain compliance with the laws, rules and regulations of the grant, including compliance with all state and federal grant eligibility requirements as outlined in the Addendum. Following this contract term, Plano shall be the billing entity for this project and responsible for payment of any subscription fees or renewal fees.
