- ❖ RYA Baseball utilizes the Parks and Recreation facilities located at Richfield Park & Cross Timbers Park
- ❖ The Baseball program is one of the oldest in Tarrant County
- ❖ RYA has both a recreational and premier Baseball program
- ❖ Scheduled 6 tournaments in 2020-cancelled due to COVID



# Football

- ❖ RYA offers recreational Football programs at Richfield Park
- ❖ Football programs begin at age 4, up to age 12
- ❖ RYA Football is currently a member of the Northwest Texas Youth Football Association [nwtyfa.org](http://nwtyfa.org)



# Cheerleading

**Director: Lisa Willis**

- ❖ RYA hosts Cheerleading in conjunction with our football program
- ❖ The Cheer program begins at age 4, and up to age 13
- ❖ During 2020, RYA registered 25 Cheerleaders, forming 2 Cheer teams





# Basketball

**Director: Blair Armfield**

- ❖ Our Basketball program has continued to grow and has become a very competitive league with 284 Co-ed Players and 30 teams.
- ❖ Basketball practices are held at NRH Baptist Church, Birdville Baptist Church, and The Link. Games are held at North Richland Middle School for the 9-12yo's & 5-8yo's at The Link in Richland Hills.
- ❖ The season consists of 8 games. Playoffs cancelled due to COVID.



# Super Kids

**Vice Commissioner: Tim Earley**

- ❖ RYA hosts a successful program for mentally and/or physically handicapped children & adults
- ❖ The Super Kids program consists of Baseball, Football, Basketball, and Cheerleading
- ❖ Super Kids Baseball, Football, and Cheerleading are located at Richfield Park & Cross Timbers Park
- ❖ Super Kids Basketball is located at Fort Worth Christian
- ❖ In 2020 we had 30 participants in the Super Kids program



# 2020 Financial Review

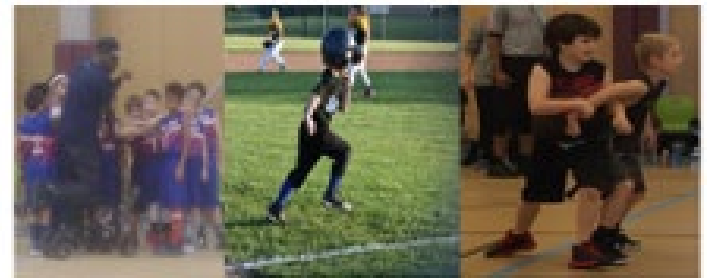
- ❖ RYA is current with City Electric and Maintenance Fee billing
- ❖ Baseball Fees remained the same, Basketball increased by \$5.00
- ❖ Football & Cheer registration fees remained the same
- ❖ Renewed insurance policy in 2020 at a cost of \$7,500
- ❖ Major expenses (\$90k yearly) include Umpire Fees, City Maintenance Fees, Field Utilities (lights), and Gym Rentals
- ❖ The convicted individual continues to make monthly restitution, with 2 years remaining until completion
