SUBJECT: Consider Resolution No. 2023-060, designating the Chief of Police as the grantee's authorized official for the Office of the Governor's Homeland Security Division FY2022 North Texas Anti-Gang Center Program, Grant #2848908.

PRESENTER: Mike Young, Chief of Police

SUMMARY:

The city is currently the grantee for the Office of the Governor's Homeland Security Division FY2022 North Texas Anti-Gang Center (TAG) Program, grant #2848908. North Richland Hills serves as the fiduciary and sponsoring agency for this grant and supports TAG in its mission to combat gang violence through the coordination of gang prevention, intervention, and suppression activities. To accept and commit funds on behalf of the Police Department, an authorized official must be designated and granted authority by the grantee's governing body.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

An authorized official must be designated and granted authority by the grantee's governing body for the FY2022 North Texas Anti-Gang Center Program, Grant #2848908 offered through the Office of the Governor.

Staff is requesting that Chief of Police Mike Young be designated as the authorized official and be given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the funding request on behalf of the North Richland Hills Police Department.
