SUBJECT: Consider Resolution No. 2018-011, acceptance of police tactical

equipment from the City of Irving awarded from a regional SWEEP Grant Fund from the North Central Texas Council of Governments and authorize the City Manager to execute an Equipment Transfer

SUMMARY:

The North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) has transferred "SWEEP funds" from the SWAT Training Project to the FY18 Regional SWAT Night Vision Project. This project will fund the purchase of 46 night vision devices to be distributed throughout the region. The City of Irving (Irving), serving as the grant sub-recipient, will purchase the equipment. Upon receipt, Irving will transfer 12 night vision devices to the City of North Richland Hills (City) as the receiving jurisdiction.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The NCTCOG de-obligates and re-allocates funds twice a year. These funds are called "SWEEP funds." The December 2017 SWEEP funds were re-allocated to the FY18 Regional SWAT Night Vision Project. Irving as the Sub-Recipient will purchase the SWEEP-funded night vision equipment for the region. Upon receipt, Irving will transfer 12 night vision devices to the City.

As the receiving jurisdiction, the City must execute a Regional Equipment Transfer Agreement agreeing to maintain compliance with the laws, rules and regulations of the grant, including compliance with all state and federal grant eligibility requirements as outlined in the Grantee Conditions and Responsibilities Memo and the Supplemental Statement of Grant Award.
