KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT I, A. G. Meacham, Owner of the following 11.956 acres of land out of J. H. Barlough Survey, Abstract No. 130, in Tarrant County, Texas:

Beginning at an iron pin 3372.9 feet north of and 25 feet west of a sandstone set at the northeast corner of a 10 acre tract out of the J. H. Barlough Survey, said point being in the west right of way line of Smithfield road, County Project No. 3004;

Thence south 856 feet to an iron pin for a corner;

Thence west 1000 feet to an iron pin for a corner;

Thence north 200 feet to an iron pin for a corner;

Thence west 25 feet to a point in the south right of way line of the St. Louis Southwestern Railroad Co.;

Thence N. 54° 59' E. in the south right of way line of said railroad 353 feet to a point;

Thence S. 35° 01' E., 50 feet to a point;

Thence N. 54° 59' E. in the said south right of way line of said railroad 865.3 feet to the place of beginning and containing 11.956 acres of land, more or less, and being 11.956 acres out of a 42.5 acre tract deeded to A.
