SUBJECT: Discuss North College Circle Traffic
PRESENTER: Boe Blankenship, Director of Public Works

SUMMARY:

Staff will present a brief overview of the North College Circle corridor as part of a traffic safety discussion. The presentation will include traffic speed and volume data, recent intersection warrant studies, accident history and proposed plans to revise / re-install signage and pavement markings for improved visibility.



North College Circle was constructed in the early 1960s as part of the College Hills development. Today it connects Davis Boulevard to Holiday Lane, serving the Fort Worth Christian campus and hundreds of nearby residential properties.

The Minor Collector designation for this roadway is a function of its role in providing a key connection to major roadways for area residents, the school, and adjacent businesses. As such North College Circle has higher vehicular volumes than nearby residential roadways. With this in mind, the roadway was originally constructed at approximately 36' wide unlike

the city's standard residential roadway which is 30' wide. The majority of adjacent residential properties actually face the side streets (Terry, Deaver, Bogart) with the higher volume College Circle running alongside rather than in front of the homes.
