**SUBJECT:** Consider authorizing the City Manager to execute an interlocal agreement with Tarrant County to rehabilitate Bursey Road from Bursey Road South to Hunter Lane.

### **SUMMARY:**

The City Council is being asked to consider an interlocal agreement between Tarrant County and the City of North Richland Hills for road construction work on Bursey Road beginning at Bursey Road South and ending at Hunter Lane.

### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

Over the past several years Tarrant County Field Operations, Precinct No. 3 has helped the city complete various street rehabilitation projects. The most recent project, Sunset Road from Mid-Cities Boulevard to Rufe Snow Drive, was completed in the summer of 2023. This year's preventive street maintenance program is incorporating a partnership with Tarrant County to perform asphalt rehabilitation services on Bursey Road.

The rehabilitation will be performed on 2,021 linear feet of asphalt pavement from Bursey Road South to just past Hunter Lane. The project will consist of concrete curb and gutter repairs as needed, subgrade stabilization, and new asphalt pavement. Bursey Road is classified as a C4U Major Collector which carries a high volume of vehicles daily. The condition has deteriorated to the extent that less extensive maintenance techniques are insufficient, and the full-depth subgrade stabilization and pavement replacement is needed to rehabilitate the roadway.

The terms and conditions of the agreement are attached. The key responsibilities of the City will be to pay for materials, trucking charges, one-half of the fuel used by Tarrant County for the subgrade stabilization process, and the placement of the asphalt in the roadway. Utilizing an interlocal agreement satisfies state law that would require the city to solicit competitive bids.

Once the agreement is executed, staff will coordinate with Tarrant County to schedule the work. At this time, we anticipate construction to occur this summer and the work is expected to take 4 to 5 weeks to complete.



**Recommendation:**

Authorize the City Manager to execute an interlocal agreement with Tarrant County to rehabilitate Bursey Road from Bursey Road South to Hunter Lane.
