SUBJECT: Approve Resolution No. 2023-030, authorizing the City Manager to

execute a Regional Asset Transfer Addendum with the City of Dallas to transfer equipment purchased from multiple vendors by the City of North Richland Hills through city-approved purchasing policies,

using TAG Grant #2848908 funds.

SUMMARY:

The City of North Richland Hills ("NRH") serves as the fiduciary and grant recipient for the FY2023 North Texas Anti-Gang Center ("TAG") Project Grant. The grant award includes funding for the purchase of pre-approved equipment using TAG Grant #2848908 funds and the subsequent transfer of ownership and responsibility of the assets to the City of Dallas ("Dallas"), a TAG Constituent Agency.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

NRH will be purchasing the following equipment using TAG Grant #2848908 funds:

10 Cellular Charging Stations	
Reader Media Subscription for 3 users	
Reader Media Subscription for 3 users	

This equipment will be purchased by NRH from multiple vendors in accordance with the City's approved purchasing policies. None of the purchases are collectively over \$50,000 with a single vendor. Upon execution of a Regional Asset Transfer Addendum, NRH will transfer ownership and responsibility of the listed assets to Dallas. As the receiving jurisdiction, Dallas agrees to maintain compliance with the laws, rules and regulations of the grant, including compliance with all state and federal grant eligibility requirements as outlined in the addendum.
