

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-065

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RICHLAND HILLS, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE DESIGNATION OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE AS THE GRANTEE'S AUTHORIZED OFFICIAL FOR THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR'S FY2023 BULLET-RESISTANT SHIELD PROGRAM, GRANT #4631601.

WHEREAS, The City of North Richland Hills, Texas possesses legal authority to apply for and to make appointments for the conduct of business relative to the Office of the Governor's Grant FY2023 Bullet-Resistant Shield Program, Grant #4631601; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of North Richland Hills finds it is in the best interest of the citizens of North Richland Hills to grant authority to the Chief of Police to accept and commit grant funds on behalf of the North Richland Hills Police Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH RICHLAND HILLS, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City of North Richland Hills hereby finds that the recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution as if written herein.

SECTION 2. The City Council of the City of North Richland Hills designates Chief of Police Mike Young as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the funding request on behalf of the applicant agency.

SECTION 3. The City Council of the City of North Richland Hills agrees that the loss or misuse of the Office of the Governor funds or failure to comply with all award requirements may result in suspension or termination of award funds, the repayment of award funds, and/or other remedies by law.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the date of its adoption, and it is so resolved; and all Resolutions of the City Council of the City in conflict herewith are hereby amended or repealed to the extent of such conflict.
