The potential questions or issues from the Planning Department are proactively addressed with this document:

- 1. Site Planning document Attached (see page 2)
- 2. Participant Parking included as part of Site Planning Document Attached (see page 2)
 - a. This area will be managed by members of Christian Classic Cruisers, directing participants to the correct parking area.
 - b. This will be visibly managed with signage and personnel.
 - c. Only those vehicles participating (officially registered) in the event will have entrance to this area.
 - d. Entrance will only be from Mid Cities Blvd.
- 3. Spectator Parking included as part of Site Planning Document Attached (see page 2)
 - a. The general public spectator (non-participant) will be parking in the area on the north side of the stadium.
 - b. Only pedestrian traffic for spectators is allowed in the immediate car show area.
- 4. Restrooms facilities
 - a. Agreement with the various restaurants (What-a-burger, Taco Bueno, CiCi's, Ihop, and Panda Express)
 - i. Both What-a Burger and Taco Bueno are annual Sponsors for each show, providing handicapped approved restrooms for both spectators and participants, males and females, with no purchase required.
 - b. Rental of TWO port-a-potties (one handicap accessible) to be placed on the parking lot for each event.
- 5. Traffic Control
 - a. There is no anticipation of requirements for NRH Traffic Control. There is a typical dispersment of the spectator crowd during the award ceremonies. Most participants will not leave until all awards are given out, and then will leave at will. This activity has been held at BISD for several years (18 years) and was previously held at North Hills Mall during 2003 and 2004, and the Antique Mall on Rufe Snow for 2000 through 2002 and Burger Street on Harwood and Hwy121 for the eight years prior. No previous requirements or needs were presented for Traffic Control.
