Sponsorship for the 2024 Neighborhood Initiative Program.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The Neighborhood Initiative Program (NIP) has assisted elderly, single parents, persons with disabilities, and veterans with minor exterior home repairs since 2004.

Projects may include exterior home maintenance, repairs, and yard work. This program helps residents continue living safely and comfortably in their own homes and helps to make their neighborhoods a better place to live. This joint effort between the City of North Richland Hills, businesses, non-profits, and churches is helping homeowners who are struggling make necessary exterior home repairs.

Donations are significant to the work of the Neighborhood Initiative Program. Donations are used to purchase building materials, tools, supplies, and equipment needed to complete home maintenance projects.

Each January we send out a call for donations to our local businesses. This year New Armor Restoration reached out to city staff about partnering with the City of North Richland Hills as the Title Sponsor for this year's Neighborhood Initiative Program and Fix It Blitz.

New Armor Restoration is a veteran-owned and operated company whose mission is to provide high-quality restoration services in a timely manner. The company's core values include - community, work ethic, transparency, compassion, and dependability. New Armor is deeply committed to the community; and actively supports local charities, schools, and various veteran causes.
