#### SIGN UP

#### **READ**

Books, comics, even audiobooks -- any time you spend reading from May 30 to August 5 counts! The important thing is to have fun while doing it.



#### **TRACK & LOG**

Using Beanstack, log how many minutes you spend reading each day and any activities you complete!



#### **EARN BADGES**

As you progress through the Mayor's Summer Reading Club, you'll earn virtual badges. Some badges even award you prizes and virtual tickets!

#### READING REWARDS

As you earn badges throughout the Mayor's Summer Reading Club, you will be rewarded with different goodies to pick up from the Library and virtual tickets for our grand prize drawings! Rewards include day passes to NRH<sub>2</sub>O for children and teens who read 50 hours\*, coupons from local businesses, tote bags for adults, and much more! 


