Hometown of North Richland Hills is one of the first New Urban Traditional Neighborhood Developments in North Texas. The 650 acre area features a wide mix of uses to promote a growing community as it leads North Texas into the future. Road diets ensure calm traffic and pedestrian safety. A street art campaign with over half a dozen quality public art pieces have been commissioned throughout the neighborhood.

The Hometown area is planned to be within half a mile from a commuter rail station where pedestrians can walk to their mixed income and mixed generational housing and commercial districts. Schools and the community library are all nearby the neighborhoods, offices, and commercial locations; all of which are monitored by an architectural management team and process to maximize the aesthetic pleasure of the built environment. Neighborhoods feature a variety of fitness and recreation facilities, such as, its 3 hockey rinks, water parks, and 86 acres of public parks.

Hometown of North Richland Hills is aiming to be an enjoyable and safe place for Texans to live and visit for years to come.
