SUBJECT: Authorize the purchase of the SmartForce Agency Management

System from Adventos Corporation for the Texas Anti-Gang Center

Project in the amount of \$60,104.17

SUMMARY:

The SmartForce Agency Management System by Adventos (SmartForce) is a state-of-the-art software system that helps public safety agencies become more efficient and better connected. SmartForce will organize and disseminate data between the six Texas Anti-Gang Centers (TAG Centers) and local, regional, state and federal agencies.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The City of North Richland Hills serves as the fiduciary for the FY18 North Texas Anti-Gang Center Project Grant. The grant funds have been authorized by the Criminal Justice Division of the Texas Governor's Office for the SmartForce purchase. For the TAG Centers to work more efficiently and to manage pro-active policing strategies, use-of-force reporting, and other workflows, staff is requesting authorization to purchase the SmartForce Agency Management System from Adventos in the amount of \$60,104.17. Adventos Corporation has provided a sole source statement for this system.
