**Subject:** Approve purchase of a bucket truck for the Public Works Department from Altec Industries, Inc. in the amount of \$130,476.00 through a National Joint Powers Alliance Contract.

### **Summary:**

The 2017-18 budget includes the replacement of a bucket truck for the Public Works Department. It is being recommended to purchase this truck from Altec Industries through National Joint Powers Alliance Contract #031014-ALT.

### **General Description:**

The CIP Major Capital Equipment Replacement Program generally consists of equipment with a minimum ten-year replacement schedule. At the ten-year interval, the equipment is evaluated for replacement based on frequency of use, the number of like equipment in the fleet, equipment condition, and the availability of parts and services. Many times, we find value in extending the replacement beyond 10 years. A 1998 Chevrolet Kodiak bucket truck utilized by the Public Works Department is now ready for replacement.

The City of North Richland Hills is a member of several inter-local groups and utilizes existing contracts with vendors through the Local Government Purchasing Cooperatives.

Altec Industries has submitted a quote using National Joint Powers Alliance (NJPA) Contract #031014-ALT totaling \$130,476.00. City staff is recommending purchasing the bucket truck through this NJPA contract. The City has conducted previous business with Altec Industries with good results.
