a BuyBoard Contract

Summary:

The 2018-19 budget includes the replacement of a skid steer loader and street sweeper for the Public Works Department. It is being recommended to purchase this equipment from Associated Supply Company, Inc., (ASCO) through BuyBoard Contract #515-16.

General Description:

The CIP Major Capital Equipment Replacement Program requires a minimum ten-year replacement for major capital equipment. At the ten-year interval, the equipment is evaluated for replacement based on frequency of use, the number of like equipment in the fleet, equipment condition, and the availability of parts and services. The table below shows a breakdown of the equipment being purchased.

The City of North Richland Hills is a member of several inter-local groups and utilizes existing contracts with vendors through local government purchasing cooperatives. The Local Government Code states that purchases made through a cooperative purchasing agreement satisfy any state law that would require the city to solicit competitive bids.

ASCO has submitted BuyBoard quotes through contract #515-16 in the amount of \$131,450.00. The quotes also included a trade-in value of \$12,500.00 for the old skid steer and street sweeper. The city has conducted previous business with ASCO with good results.
