**B.1 APPROVE RESOLUTION 2019-001, ESTABLISHING QUIET ZONES AT ALL RAILROAD CROSSINGS WITHIN THE CITY OF NORTH RICHLAND HILLS.**

**APPROVED**

Director of Public Works Caroline Waggoner informed Council the item before them this evening is to approve a resolution establishing quiet zones in North Richland Hills. The

TEXRail project is nearing completion and upgrades (safety features) to ten roadway crossings in North Richland Hills are complete. The upgrades were necessary in order for the roadway crossings to be designated as quiet zones by the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA). A Notice of Establishment, seeking the official quiet zone designation, was sent to the Federal Railroad Administration on December 13, 2018. The quiet zone will go into effect 21 days after receipt of the Notice of Establishment. Staff anticipates the quiet zone to go into effect January 4, 2019.
