SUBJECT: Authorize the city manager to execute an agreement with the North Central Texas Council of Governments for the Clean Fleets North Texas 2018 Grant Program for the purchase of a new quint fire truck using Buy Board Contract #571-18 awarded to Siddons Martin Emergency Group.

SUMMARY:

Authorize the city manager to execute an agreement with the North Central Texas Council of Governments for the Clean Fleets North Texas 2018 Grant Program for the purchase of a new quint fire truck using Buy Board Contract #571-18 awarded to Siddons Martin Emergency Group.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

On January 14, 2019 City Council authorized a budget adjustment and also the purchase of a new quint fire truck because of the city's award of grant funds from the Clean Fleets North Texas 2018 Grant program. This grant will reimburse the city up to a maximum of \$300,000 for the purchase of a new quint fire truck as part of the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) Diesel Emissions Reduction Act (DERA).

The attached agreement is the final execution document necessary for acceptance of the Clean Fleets North Texas 2018 Grant. This agreement will be between the city and the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) and will run through December 13, 2019.

State law authorizes a local government to purchase goods or services from other local governments or cooperative entities, thereby satisfying any requirement to competitively bid the item.
