## SUMMARY:

Council is required to canvass the votes cast at the City Council Election held on May 4, 2019. Resolution No. 2019-023 formally accepts the results of the election and declares the winning candidates.

## **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

The Texas Election Code requires that the City Council meet after the General Election to canvass the results of the election. The unofficial results received from Tarrant County Elections are as follows:

There are a few outstanding military ballots. If the ballots are received by the deadline of Friday, May 10, the results could potentially change prior to canvass. If the ballots are returned in accordance with state law and the Early Voting Ballot Board qualifies the ballots, the unofficial results will be updated to reflect any changes. Should there be any changes, City Council will be provided the revised unofficial results and a revised resolution prior to the canvass.
