Richland Tennis Center—RTC will host a UTR (Universal Tennis

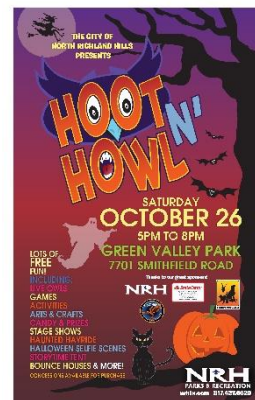

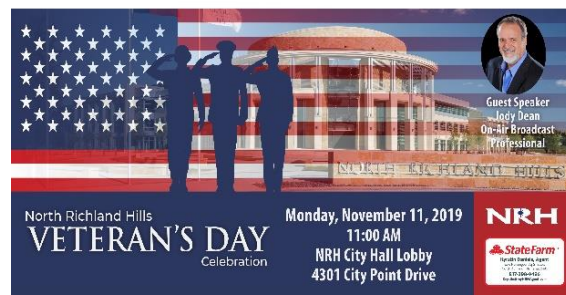


NRH Pop Up Art Gallery Call for Art—The NRH Pop Up Art Gallery call for art is going on now and an artist reception will be held on Friday, November
