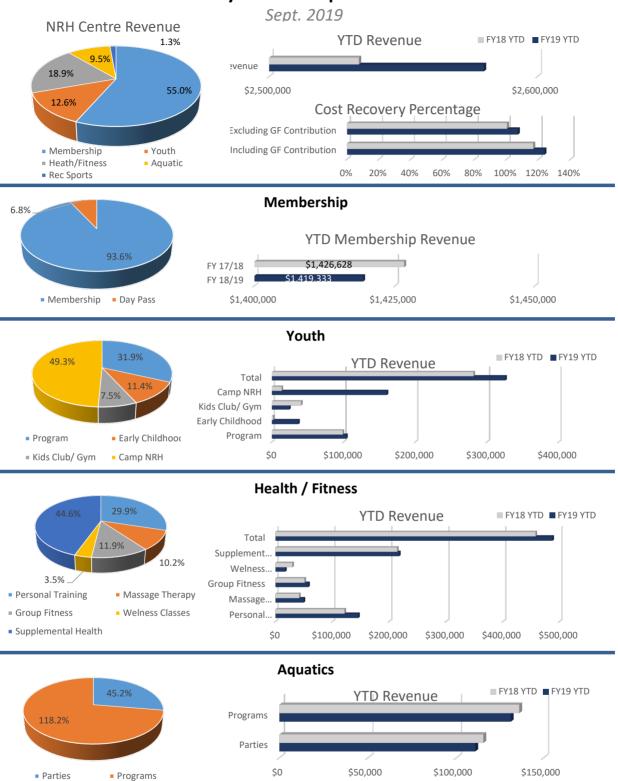

# **NRH Centre Highlights**

FY18/19 total facility revenues excluding Grand Hall and General Fund Contributions came in at \$2,579,839 improving on PY's record benchmark by \$46,473. NRH Centre Cost Recovery came in at 103% against PY's 100%, this includes all capital improvement projects throughout the facility. With General Fund contributions, the NRH Centre operated at 119% cost recovery against PY's 116%.

#### **Membership Highlights**

Membership revenues came in at \$1,419,333 against PY revenues of \$1,426,628, missing revenues by (\$7,295). There was a steady decline in membership in the months of August and September 2019 due to the replaster project in the aquatics area, but membership is expected to bounce back in the coming months for FY19/20

## **Youth Highlights**

NRH Centre Youth Program revenues (not including Camp NRH or Early Childhood development) came in at a record high of \$103,858.61 for FY18/19. Youth program revenue have jumped 32% in the last two years alone. Camp NRH came in with record highs as well generating \$161k in total revenues a 26% growth rate over PY and an improvement of 106% since FY16/17.

#### **Health/Fitness Highlights**

Personal Training revenues came in at \$145,507 improving on PY numbers by 20%, Massage revenues came in at \$49,631 an improvement over PY actuals by 19% and Group Fitness revenues came in at \$57,783 and improvement of 13% over PY Actuals

### **Aquatic Highlights**

Total Aquatics revenues came in at \$244,929 missing PY by \$9,854. This was a huge win as this division was trending \$30k over PY revenues for much of the year until repair was needed to last year's pool replaster project. Closure in Sept. affected programming and Private/Open Swim party revenues which caused this miss.
