At each City Council meeting a member of the governing body announces upcoming events and recognizes an employee who exemplifies our core values.

Announcements:

Republic Services is asking residents to make sure all household trash is bagged and tied before placing it in your trash can or on the curb. Doing this helps to protect trash crews from the spread of germs and also keeps litter out of our neighborhoods. Since recyclables are collected by an automated truck, they do not need to be bagged and you can continue placing directly into your recycling cart. Residents should also refrain from placing large amounts of bulk and yard waste materials out for collection at this time, so crews can focus on collection of household waste.

As a reminder, city offices and facilities remain closed to the public and special events, programs and classes are canceled. During this time, you can still access our city offices by phone or email, and utilize online services through our website. We also continue to provide public safety services without interruption.
