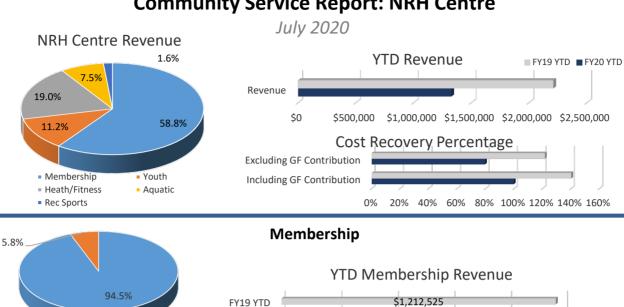
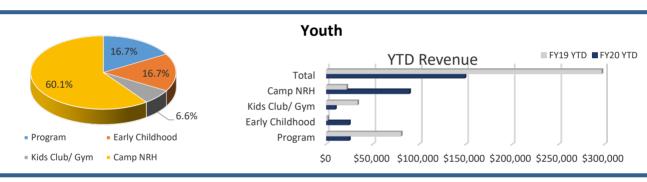

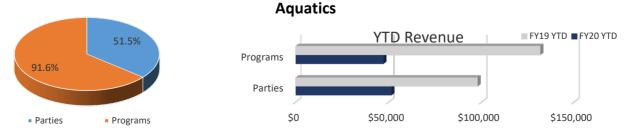

### NRH Centre Highlights

The NRH Centre generated \$88,799 in total operating revenues without Grand Hall or GF Contributions, \$89,384 with Grand Hall Contributions. June Facility Cost Recovery came in at 45.3% without GF contributions and 65.9% with GF Contributions. YTD Cost Recovery sits at 79.5% without GF Contributions and 99.7% with GF Contributions.

### **COVID 19 Budget Revisions**

In June the NRH Centre revised the FY19/20 revenue to account for closures and capacity restrictions due to COVID-19. Total revenue reduction including the Grand Hall was \$1,035,156

#### **Membership Highlights**

For the month of June we sold 149 memberships against PY's 280. We are seeing the biggest membership sales misses in Annual Pass Sales due to no membership promotions and the overall uncertainty created by COVID.

#### **Youth Highlights**

The month of July saw 270 registered kids for Camp NRH against PY's actuals of 489. Numbers have remained steady each week throughout the summer, hovering around 54 kids per week.

## **Health/Fitness Highlights**

Wellness revenues came in at \$14,391 missing PY revenues by (\$28,196). The majority of the miss is coming from the supplemental health line and a lighter month in personal training revenues.

#### **Aquatic Highlights**

Aquatic Swim Lessons generated \$6,478 in total revenues against PY's \$40,320. The reduction in revenues are due to not currently offering Private Swim Parties and not being able to offer as many swim lessons due to capacity restrictions.
