SUBJECT: Authorize the City Manager to execute an interlocal agreement with Tarrant County to rehabilitate and resurface Stonybrooke Drive from Rumfield Road to Crestview Drive.

SUMMARY:

The City Council is being asked to authorize the City Manager to execute an interlocal agreement between Tarrant County and the City of North Richland Hills for road construction work on Stonybrooke Drive.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Over the past few years Tarrant County Field Operations, specifically Precinct No. 3 has helped the City complete various street construction projects. Most recently county forces rehabilitated Meadow Road in 2020. This partnership allows the City to stretch maintenance dollars by taking advantage of the county's in-house capabilities.

The proposed 2021 project is Stonybrooke Drive from Rumfield Road to Crestview Drive, and will include full sub-grade stabilization followed by a new asphalt surface.

The terms and conditions of the agreement replicate those used in prior years. The City will pay for the materials, trucking charges and one half of the fuel used by Tarrant County for the sub-grade stabilization process and the placement of the asphalt in the roadway. Once the agreement is executed staff will coordinate with the county to schedule the work, which will be funded as part of the 2021 Preventive Street Maintenance program (SM2101).

At this time, it is anticipated that the work will take place in October of 2021. The work is estimated to take 3 to 4 weeks to complete.

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the City Manager to execute an interlocal agreement with Tarrant County to rehabilitate and resurface Stonybrooke Drive from Rumfield Road to Crestview Drive.
