**SUBJECT:** Approve Interlocal Agreement with Birdville Independent School District (“BISD”) for Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (“COPS”) School Violence Prevention Program Grant with local matching funds in the amount of \$26,750.00.

### **SUMMARY:**

The COPS School Violence Prevention Program awarded grant funding to the City of North Richland Hills (“City”) to purchase collaborative response graphic tools that will provide comprehensive school and campus site mapping to coordinate emergency response to critical school incidents. The grant funding applied to the purchase will be \$80,248.50, with total project cost of \$106,998. BISD agrees to pay the City \$26,750.00, which is the required 25% match of the total grant amount.

### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION:**

The City and BISD desire to enter into an Interlocal Agreement for the purpose of providing school safety measures in and around BISD K-12 (primary and secondary) schools and school grounds. The use of visual communication and collaboration tools will provide first responders with situational maps of all 32 school campuses (the “Services”) in BISD. BISD will grant the City the right to enter onto the school campus facilities for the purpose of video and photographic recording and mapping, including any installation of necessary technological infrastructure to complete the Services. BISD agrees to pay the City \$26,750.00, which will be counted as the required 25% match of the total project cost for the grant.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**
