GENERAL INFORMATION

The 2019 Citizen Survey Report gave the Library a 97% score on citizen satisfaction. Compared with benchmark cities libraries (90%) and State libraries (67%), our score is very impressive.

The Library received the Texas Municipal Library Directors Association Award for five consecutive years. Only 53 libraries in Texas received this Award.
